Element	Description
General	<input type="checkbox"/> Your website should include an index page and at least three (3) additional pages. <input type="checkbox"/> All pages should be styled using an external CSS file. <input type="checkbox"/> Include divs and/or floating elements as part of the layout for at least some pages.
Images	<input type="checkbox"/> Every page should include at least one image or other type of visual element. <input type="checkbox"/> All images should include both captions and alt text.
Lists	<input type="checkbox"/> Your site should include at least one simple list and one complex list with nesting. <input type="checkbox"/> Use classes to make your lists more readable and more visually appealing.
Tables	<input type="checkbox"/> Tables should be styled using the external CSS file. <input type="checkbox"/> At least one table should be complex. <input type="checkbox"/> All tables should be styled in a way that makes them readable and visually appealing.
Forms	<input type="checkbox"/> Your site should include a form with at least three (3) form elements.
Links	<input type="checkbox"/> Include both internal and external links. <input type="checkbox"/> The link text should be descriptive.
Multimedia	<input type="checkbox"/> Include at least one video
